These fundraisers are successful only when we have **100% PARTICIPATION in volunteer hours and monies.**

Band-Aid was developed as a way to avoid multiple fundraising efforts and ensure the band has sufficient funding for the band program. **Each family is asked to make a \$100 contribution.** Band-Aid money goes directly back to the students through additional instruction by adjunct staff, field show expenses, band equipment, and coach bus upgrades so our children travel comfortably and SAFELY. **Without this contribution from each family, the MWBB cannot provide these items that are instrumental to our program of excellence here at Millard West.**
