Course Description: This course is for all students in grade 9 who play a band instrument and have an interest in symphonic band and marching band literature. Emphasis will be on advanced instrumental technique and ensemble rehearsal skills, music literacy, music history, and performance practice. The best in modern wind band literature, as well as standard classics, will serve as the repertoire. Students will also have the opportunity to audition for Orchestra winds and percussion and a vast array of other small ensembles, including Jazz Band, Chamber Winds, Brass Choir, Woodwind Choir, Percussion Ensemble, and others. This course will also include performances outside of the normal school day.

Materials Required

Instrument, music, drill and nail bag during marching season, and pencil. Music will be provided by the instructors during the course of the year.

Course Requirements

- Daily work on Instrumental Technique and Rehearsal Etiquette
- Assignments and Quizzes in Music Theory
- Assignments related to repertoire being rehearsed
- Attendance/ participation at all performances
